



Suggested Lesson Plan for Intro - ABC

This lesson should take about 4 or 5 academic hours to teach and practice. One academic hour is 40 minutes. However, if you have a class of very smart kids, this should take less time.

Goal: To get the kids to say the letters of the alphabet. Or you can use the same cards to teach sounds of the alphabet.

Vocabulary : Letters or Sounds of the alphabet.

PRESENTATION STAGE

Powerpoint: Use the powerpoint to present the vocabulary of alphabet letters. Do not teach all in one day. Try 5 or 6 letters each lesson. Use the flashcards if you have no computers or projectors in class.

PRACTICE STAGE

Flashcard Games: Use the small-sized alphabet flashcards to play a game. If you teach six letters in one lesson for example, print out the first page of the alphabet cards with 6 letters **A** to **F**. Kids sit in a circle. Point to the cards and let them repeat the names of each card. Display the cards on the floor or table they are seated around in the correct order of the alphabet. Ask them to close their eyes. Then take out a card each time and ask them which card is missing. You keep doing this until they can remember all the letters.

Flashcard Phonics Game: Teach them the sounds of the alphabet and play the same game with cards as above but ask them which sound is missing. So teach them the sound first.

Writing Worksheets: Take out 6 worksheets from the handwriting and phonics set that correspond to the 6 letters you have taught in that lesson. The kids write the missing letters in the word. Same cards can be used for phonics and handwriting.

PRODUCTION/OUTPUT STAGE

After you have finished teaching alphabets in about 4 to 5 lessons, use the 3 alphabet worksheets for the kids to write.
